Please use the following list to select the dance wear that will serve you best in class. Dancers should keep all dance supplies and shoes in a dedicated dance bag for class. **Please remember your water bottle!**

We have created an online shop with suggested apparel, just for you! Visit the family portal to see some great dancewear, shoes, and tights that are dress code approved. All orders will be shipped to the studio for you to pick up. We invite non-binary students to make selections that feel correct for them, and invite conversation about selecting comfortable attire.

Not sure what size to get? Stop by the front desk to try on samples before you order.

*Some specialized items (pointe shoes, undergarments, etc.) are not available via the Portal Shop. We can provide you with other means of purchasing these items.

Cell Phone Policy: dancers in two or more classes must check in their cell phone at the lobby desk. Dancers who have a break between classes may request to use their phones during a break, but then must return their phones to the desk until the end of class.

CREATIVE KIDS

Dancers should wear comfortable clothing to move in. A leotard, tights and a skirt is a great option, but leggings and fitted shirts work as well. Please no big dresses/skirts or jeans.

Footwear:

Dance With Me - barefoot

Tumble Tots - barefoot

Hip Hop Hooray- barefoot

Discover Dance- ballet shoes in pink or a skin-matching shade

Ballet/Jazz/Tap- tan Mary-Jane tap shoes and ballet shoes in pink or a skin-matching shade

Ballet/Jazz/Acro- ballet shoes in pink or a skin matching shade

Jazz/Acro/Hip Hop- slip on tan jazz shoe



Hair should be worn off the face in a ponytail or braids.

TRAINING PROGRAM (AGES 7-18)

For all classes the following are not permitted: large jewelry, hoop earrings, crop tops/bra tops (unless covered by a full-length top, bike shorts or running shorts with an inseam less than 6in (unless wearing tights)).

BALLET



All dancers taking ballet must wear a solid colored leotard and tights. Fitted shorts, wrap ballet skirts and warm-up sweaters (no baggy sweatshirts) can be worn over the leo/tights.

Footwear: canvas ballet shoes in pink or a skin-matching shade.

Hair must be in a bun, tight braid or french twist.

CONTEMPORARY

All dancers taking contemporary should wear a solid colored leotard. Form-fitting tank tops and tee shirts are also permitted. Skirts, shorts, leggings, and warm-up sweaters can be worn over the leotard.

Footwear: barefoot.

Hair should be worn off the face in a ponytail, bun or braids.

HIP HOP

Dancers taking hip hop are allowed to wear loose-fitting clothing like joggers, leggings, tank tops and tee shirts; however jeans are not permitted.

Footwear: clean black sneakers with white or tan soles (NO OUTSIDE FOOTWEAR)

Hair should be secured neatly off the face.



JAZZ

Dancers taking jazz/musical theater should wear a solid colored leotard and tights. Form-fitting tank tops and tee shirts are also permitted. Skirts, shorts, leggings, and warm-up sweaters can be worn over the leo/tights.

Footwear: tan leather flat slip-on jazz shoe. Levels 4 and 5 will alternate between jazz shoes and heels.

Hair should be worn off the face in a ponytail, bun or braids.



TAP

Dancers taking tap are allowed to wear loose-fitting clothing like joggers, leggings, tank tops and tee shirts; however jeans are not permitted.

Footwear: Level 1 should wear tan Mary Jane tap shoes. All other levels wear black oxford tap shoes (hard sole).

Hair should be secured neatly off the face.

ACRO DANCE

All dancers taking acrobatics must wear a solid colored leotard and tights. Fitted shorts and leggings can be worn over the leo/tights, but may have to be removed at the discretion of the instructor in order to assess placement or offer hands-on spotting/correction.

Footwear: dancers must be barefoot. No socks.

Hair should be worn in a low ponytail or braids.



STUDENT ASSISTANTS/INTERNS

Dancers taking part in the SA/Intern program are asked to wear proper dance attire for any class they are assisting in (footwear included). While working, dancers are required to wear their SA/Intern uniform tee shirt, which will be provided.

MOMENTUM COMPANY

Dancers in Momentum must wear a black leotard and tights or leggings for **all rehearsals**. Dancers will be provided with the team tank top/tee shirt each season as part of the performance uniform.

Hair should be off the face in a ponytail, bun or braid.
